



7 DAYS MIGRATION CALVARY SAFARI

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TRIP OVERVIEW

Every year, the vast heads of wildebeest embark on a long –distance migration that coincide with the annual rainfall patterns and grass growth.

Following the short rainy season in November, the herds of wildebeest arrive to the short-grass plains of the Serengeti around November.

The short-grass plains are located in the area east and south of the Seronera, around Ndutu and the northern Ngorongoro Conservation Area.

Herds of wildebeest and zebra can be seen across these plains as they feed o the nutrient rich grasses.

The majority of the wildebeest calve around February. They normally stay in the Area till April and then start moving west toward to the Western Corridor of the Serengeti National Park.

Our 7-days Migration Wildlife safaris, tours, holidays and travel packages, have been designed specifically to focus on and to increase your chance to see the Wildebeest Calvary Migration; we have designed the itinerary to visit South Serengeti and Central Serengeti National Park where the majority of the wildebeest migration can normally be found from December through to March.

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DETAIL ITINERARY

DAY 1: ARRIVE AT KILIMANJARO AIRPORT

Arrive at the Kilimanjaro International Airport. You will be met by our guide at the Airport and transferred to the hotel in Moshi.

Accommodation: [Panama Garden Resort](#) or similar hotel in Moshi.

Room plan: **Double Occupancy**

Meal Plan: Bed and Breakfast.

DAY 2: NGORONGORO

In the morning after breakfast you will drive to the Ngorongoro Conservation Area, and after registration you will descend to the Crater Floor. You will do a full day of game drives at the floor and have picnic lunch at the Hippo poolside picnic site. After lunch you will continue with game drives in the Crater floor in search of the rhinos, elephants, lions, buffaloes, zebras, impalas, gerenuks, etc. Ngorongoro Crater is also famous for bird life and at the Lake makat at the middle of the crater floor you can see, flamingos, pelicans Egyptian geese, and many more aquatic species. Other birds include the hammer kop, Lilac breasted rollers weavers and many more

Meal Plan: **Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner**

Accommodation: [Rhino Lodge](#) or similar lodge in Ngorongoro Conservation Area.

Room plan: **Double Occupancy**

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DAY 3: NGORONGORO TO NDUTU

After breakfast we will head to the Lake Ndutu area, situated in the Ngorongoro Conservation area, part of the Southern Serengeti Eco-system. Lake Ndutu is alkaline, like most of the other Rift lakes however the water is still drinkable and used by a wide array of local wildlife.

The majority of the wildebeest migration can normally be found on the short-grass plains from December to April. The Area is usually heavily populated with elephants, birds and resident game.

Meal Plan: **Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner**

Accommodation: [Tanzania Bush Camp](#) or similar tented Camp in South Serengeti.

Room plan: **Double Occupancy**

DAY 4: NDUTU FULL DAY

After breakfast, enjoy a full game drive in the Ndutu Area. Explore the range of different habitats that include swamps, woodland, soda lakes and the world famous Serengeti short grass plains. See great herd of wildebeest and zebra. During a short time frame around February, normally lasting for about 3 weeks, the majority of the wildebeest calve. The sea of grass provides little cover and the young are easy pickings for variety of predator. Wildebeest calves can run minutes after they are born and within 3 days they are normally strong enough to keep up with the herd.

Meal Plan: **Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner**

Accommodation: [Tanzania Bush Camp](#) or similar tented Camp in South Serengeti.

Room plan: **Double Occupancy**

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DAY 5: NDUTU TO CENTRAL SERENGETI

After breakfast we head towards the central Serengeti National Park, also known as the Seronera. We descend into the heart of wild Africa-the Serengeti National Park-with its endless plains, rolling into the distance as far as the eye can see.

We head to the Seronera area, one of the richest wildlife habitats in the park, featuring the Seronera River, which provides a valuable water source to this area and therefore attract wildlife well representative of most of the Serengeti's species.

Meal Plan: **Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner**

Accommodation: [Tanzania Bush Camp](#) or similar tented Camp in Central Serengeti.

Room plan: **Double Occupancy**

DAY 6: CENTRAL SERENGETI TO FULL DAY

On this day you will spend your time at the Serengeti plains doing game drives. Here you have the choice to do the early morning game drives if you so wish. This will give you the chance to see nocturnal species retire from a night out as well as the diurnal majority waking up for a new day

Meal Plan: **Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner**

Accommodation: [Tanzania Bush Camp](#) or similar tented Camp in Central Serengeti.

DAY 7: CENTRAL SERENGETI TO ARUSHA OR MOSHI

After breakfasts we will have enroute game drive while drive out of Serengeti National Park via Naabil gate pass through Ngorongoro Conservation Area and head to Arusha or Moshi and this will be the end of your Safari.

Meal Plan: **Breakfast and Lunch.**
