TRIP OVERVIEW

The annual Serengeti Migration of the wildebeest in Tanzania's Serengeti National Park and Kenya's Masai Mara National Reserve is one of the most spectacular wildlife events on the planet. Sometimes referred to as the 'Greatest Show on Earth', the Great Wildebeest Migration is a movement of approximately 1.5 million wildebeest throughout the Serengeti and Masai Mara ecosystems in search of green pastures and water.

Wildebeest have no natural leader and consequently herds split up and head off in different directions, meandering around and often choosing a completely different direction of travel from the one they chose yesterday. Therefore it is best to imagine the Great Migration is as one mega herd, surrounded by a number of smaller splinter herds.

Your Serengeti Central Safari in the Seronera Valley offers a year-round game-viewing mecca with impressive populations of bovids, terrestrial predators, reptiles, amphibians and birds, which remain even after the spectacular hordes of blue wildebeests and zebras, have gone

From July, August to September, the Mara River in northern Serengeti affords the most dramatic river crossings. Fierce and deep, cliff-sided and rain-swollen, the river takes an enormous toll of the exhausted and terrified wild cattle that surge through its torrential flow.

DETAIL ITINERARY

DAY 1: ARRIVE AT KILIMANJARO AIRPORT

Arrive at the Kilimanjaro International Airport. You will be met by our guide at the Airport and transferred to the hotel in Moshi.

DAY 2: NGORONGORO

In the morning after breakfast you will drive to the Ngorongoro Conservation Area, and after registration you will descend to the Crater Floor. You will do a full day of game drives at the floor and have picnic lunch at the Hippo poolside picnic site. After lunch you will continue with game drives in the Crater floor in search of the rhinos, elephants, lions, buffaloes, zebras, impalas, gerenuks, etc. Ngorongoro Crater is also famous for bird life and at the Lake makat at the middle of the crater floor you can see, flamingos, pelicans Egyptian geese, and many more aquatic species. Other birds include the hammer kop, Lilac breasted rollers weavers and many more

DAY 3: NGORONGORO TO CENTRAL SERENGETI

After breakfast at your lodge you will depart for the most famous and the first national park to be gazetted in Tanzania; The Serengeti National Park. On your way you have the chance to visit Olduvai- Gorge where human fossils were discovered by the Leakey's family suggesting that mankind started in Africa. Inside the Serengeti you expect to see lots of animals all year round but it is the Migration herds that amaze many a traveler. Resident animals include buffaloes, elephants, cheetahs, lions, baboons, zebras and so many bird species

DAY 4: CENTRAL SERENGETI TO NORTHERN SERENGETI

After breakfast in the morning we will drive from Central Serengeti with game viewing on the way to Northern Serengeti, and continue with game drives at in the endless plains of Northern Serengeti until late in the evening when we reach the lodge for dinner and overnight.

DAY 5: NORTHERN SERENGETI

This day will be spend doing game drive in Northern Serengeti areas including the Lobo area, the Bologonja areas and the Kogatende areas including a visit to the Mara River Banks on the Tanzanian sides to try and see the River crossing of the Wildebeests migration herds accompanied by some zebras and gazelles. During this time also many predators and big cats follow the animals to this area and so it is likely to see some spectacular wildlife actions like hunting.

DAY 6: NORTHERN SERENGETI TO KARATU

After breakfast in the morning we drive back from Northern Serengeti through the Central Serengeti with game viewing on the way until Naabi Hill Gate where we check out of the Serengeti National Park. We will drive then to the Karatu for Overnight.

DAY 7: KARATU TO KILIMANJARO AIRPORT
